2 If you like the Latifs' mirror (page 281), don't spend too long reflecting on it – contact Graham & Green. This Venetian-style crown example comes in two sizes, from £185. Ring 0845 1306622, or visit grahamandgreen.co.uk.

3 Re-create the softness of the entrance to Bronwyn Latif's Indian *haveli* (page 274) with this 'Rose' paint from Designers Guild. Prices start from £23 for 2.5 litres. Ring 020 7351 5775, or visit designersguild.com. If you are seeking similar floor tiles, try Fired Earth – these encaustic samples cost £93.71 per sq m. Ring 0845 3660400, or visit firedearth.com.

4 You can find a zigzag cotton flat-weave rug like the one in Bronwyn Latif's bedroom (page 280) at Madeline Weinrib Atelier, in five colourways (from \$325). 7 If you've ever wondered what it would feel like to walk in Gandhi's shoes, these replica sandals (£37 approx) – part of a tribute to the great man by fabric *grande dame* Bess Nielsen (page 328) – are for you.
